SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

The Charlize Angel LaTonya Gilliam Scholarship was established by the Foundation to memorialize Charlize Angel LaTonya Gilliam and her dream to help, inspire, and support children of all ages. Her kind, loving spirit, and commitment to education never faltered despite the challenges of her battle with cancer. This Scholarship is a part of her legacy that will be valued and beneficial for deserving students.

The purpose of the Collegiate Scholarship is to provide financial assistance to undergraduate Nursing students dedicated to helping others.


All college applicants are required to meet the following minimum eligibility criteria:

- Full-time undergraduate students at Towson University and/or Morgan State University
- Enrolled in the Nursing program classified as a Junior or Senior
- 3.0 Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) or higher
- Demonstrate a financial need as defined by the Financial Aid Office
- First preference to an applicant who is an active member of the National Pan-Hellenic Council
- Submit an essay that addresses how the applicant makes an impact on the lives of others and include work experience, community service, and participation in a fraternity or sorority (if applicable)
- The Financial Aid Office (Program Director) shall establish a process to select final recipients based on the eligibility criteria and preferences listed above, as well as additional selection criteria consistent with each school's policies prohibiting discrimination. The Financial Aid Office (Program Director) may renew the scholarship if the recipient continues to meet the minimum eligibility criteria.
